

**Terms & Conditions for Max Medical Scholarship Programme**

Class XII marksheet & certificate, NEET certificate with rank and Family Income Certificate. Max Healthcare

Foundation team may at its discretion ask an applicant to submit additional documents, on case-to-case basis,

to satisfy the eligibility criteria.

6. The applicant at the time of submitting application shall declare and undertake that information and

documents being submitted by it are true and Max Healthcare Foundation shall be entitled to reject the

application and take any other appropriate action on discovering any incorrect submission by the applicant.

7. The grant of scholarship will not confer any right in favour of the applicant and the grant shall be solely

governed by rules, procedures and criteria as per discretion of Max Healthcare Foundation which shall be final

and binding.

8. MHIL reserves the right to change, modify, add, or remove portions of the terms at any time at its discretion
